Newspapers and non-shiny sales flyers can be composted.

Paper bags without string handles can be composted.

Non-shiny junk mail—yup--can be composted.

Envelopes without plastic windows can be composted.

Cardboard boxes can be composted.

Brush chipped into mulch can be composted.

Leaves in the fall are brown compost material. (all except Oak leaves)

---All these materials are the “brown” needed in composting whereas the kitchen scraps are the “green”.

We’re in need of more of these brown materials. Now that everyone is doing so well with kitchen waste let’s step up our “brown” material too!*
