Recycling News:

Have you ever wondered what to do with worn-out clothing, sheets, shoes, etc.? The District Transfer Station now takes used clothing and textiles for special recycling. Used items can be ripped, dyed, or missing buttons and other hardware as long as they are CLEAN, DRY, AND ODORLESS. Any moldy, soiled, or damp textiles should be thrown away with regular trash.
